



## **Information on the Züri-Wiesn**

A very warm welcome!

We hope you have an enjoyable time at the Züri-Wiesn. We would ask you to show customary respect and restraint so that everyone can enjoy the event. Here are a few guidelines that will ensure a festive atmosphere for all our guests.

### **Admission**

If you have made a reservation, you will be able to collect your vouchers and entry wristbands for the Wiesnkaiser, Wiesnkönig and Braumeister options from the Wiesn-Treff ticket desk on presentation of the ticktes (order confirmation).

Last-minute visitors can benefit from our «Wiesn-Single» option at the box office at Wiesn-Treff and can grab a free or unsold seat, or wait for one to be vacated in the course of the evening.

You have to be over 18 to be admitted to the Beer Tent.

No weapons or other dangerous items are allowed anywhere inside Züri-Wiesn.

Standing on the tables is not permitted. Visitors have to pay for damaged furniture (stein 10/bench 80/table 180 Swiss francs).

The instructions of the security personnel must be followed.

Food and drink may not be brought into or taken from the Beer Tent.

The Beer Tent is a non-smoking area. Smoking is allowed in the Beer Garden.

No liability is taken for clothes and other objects.

### **Filming and photography for advertising purposes**

Films may be shot and photographs taken during the Züri-Wiesn. Wherever possible, photographers and film teams will be easily recognisable. Please avoid them if you do not wish any pictures of you to be taken that may then appear in public at a later date, or inform the photographers and film teams there and then. If you do not do this, we will assume that you agree to the images being used free of charge.

### **Sanitary facilities**

Guests in the Beer Tent can use the toilets located in the Beer Tent. Guests in the Beer Garden can use the sanitary facilities of Mc Clean situated in the first floor basement below the main station.

### **Parking**

The safest way of reaching the Züri-Wiesn and getting back home is to travel by public transport. Trains stop directly in front of the Züri-Wiesn, allowing you to celebrate stress-free.
